


# Deleting browser history: Android Google Chrome

**These instructions will explain how to delete your stored mobile Google Chrome browser data under Android (browser history, browser cache).**

1. Tap the three dots in the top right-hand corner and select the entry **History**.
2. Then tap **Clear browsing data...**
3. Select the period of time at least covering your e-banking session. For instance entry **Last hour**.
4. Then select all items.
5. Tap **Clear data**.



**Alternatively, you can also surf in incognito or private mode, so that your**

## **browser doesn't store any data in the first place.**

To do so, open a new incognito window by tapping the three dots in the top right-hand corner and then choosing **New incognito tab**.

*Browser history (also called browser cache) denotes a type of buffer memory of your browser. Browsers will store content of websites visited (e. g. images), so that they don't have to be re-downloaded every time you visit, and the site can therefore be displayed more quickly.*
