


Deleting browser history: Apple Safari

These instructions will explain how to delete your stored Apple Safari browser data (browser history, browser cache).

- 1. In the menu bar, click Safari and then Clear history.
- 2. Select the period of time at least covering your e-banking session. For instance entry **the last hour.**
- 3. Click Clear History.



Alternatively, you can also surf in incognito or private mode, so that your browser doesn't store any data in the first place.

To do so, open a new incognito window by clicking "File" and then "New Private Window". Or simultaneously press "Shift + Cmd + N".

Browser history (also called browser cache) denotes a type of buffer memory of your browser. Browsers will store content of websites visited (e. g. images), so that they don't have to be re-downloaded every time you visit, and the site can therefore be displayed more quickly.
