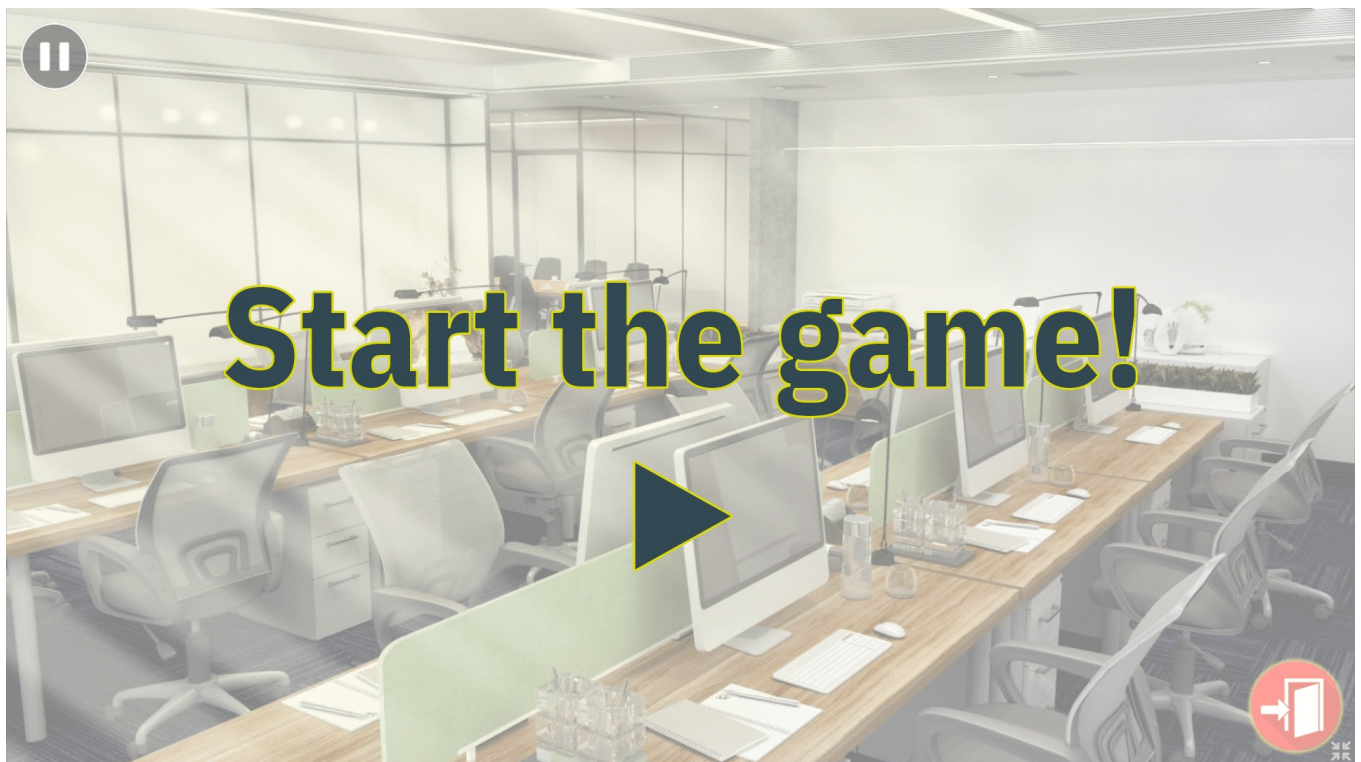


# Ransomware-Game

*Ransomware (encryption Trojans) is a certain family of malware. This usually spreads via malicious e-mail attachments or infected websites. Once installed, ransomware will encrypt files on its victims' computers and on any network drives and storage media connected to them (for instance USB sticks). Victims are then unable to use these encrypted files again.*
